**Access To The Courts** acknowledges that those criticized on this website for professional dereliction have been in positions to retaliate against Jeffrey L. Clemens, who has had to face the associated prejudice.

**The material and content on this website is the sole responsibility of its only founder, the brother of Jeffrey L. Clemens.** On Friday the 13<sup>th</sup> of January 2012, attorney-playing-victim Stephen C. Pfaff wrongly alleged that Jeffrey was a co-author of the **Access To The Courts** website. Not so, as Jeffrey has only authored cited letters and documents already of record elsewhere.

To be clear, when this site refers to Gary D. Pfaff as having been charged with ASSAULT & BATTERY, DISORDERLY CONDUCT, and DISTURBING THE PEACE, then it is **Access To The Courts**, or its founder, who presents that information, NOT Jeffrey L. Clemens. Interested parties should call Peabody (or Gloucester) District Court to verify.

Or, call Gary's brother, Stephen C. Pfaff, whom Jeffrey L. Clemens has sued for suborning perjury in a false Disorderly Conduct charge, a conviction of which has been reversed and remains not retried.
